We would like to start exchanging our first thoughts on the fundamental SCCM subject – Shared Cities: what are you doing about sharing in the city, sharing the city and sharing between the cities?

We did not want to make the topic predetermined, but to let it unfold from the works that will be presented. Since this is the first chance to present our actual works to each others - those works that are thematically connected to our general framework - shared cities, but not necessarily part of the project. We would like to understand from those works how idea of sharing could manifest itself in the concepts of urban redevelopment. Our presentations could show that we have opposite or complementary ideas about sharing and its role in today's urbanity, and we hope that these diversities will spontaneously initiate confrontations and discussions which could take us to common understandings.

Schedule of the conference is loosely defined – there are two sessions, three hours each, in the morning, and in the afternoon, and a keynote lecture at the final. It is up to you to decide how long your presentation will last (15min or 40min) and how much time you will leave for common discussions. We will all sit around one big table with audience around us, which will provide us opportunity for dynamic reactions and interchanges. We expect that, by the end of the day, each of us will find a way to share his/her standpoints so that we can start developing our common knowledge.

**We would like to discuss following questions:**

How are the aspects of sharing present in my work?

Has my work influenced any changes in my city?

Is there any similar pattern among my work and work of other partners?

What should be the impact of SCCM project?
